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1. In accordance with clause 52.216-22 (b), Indefinite Quantity (designator I71), the guaranteed minimum and maximum dollar amounts for this procurement will be calculated as follows:

a. Minimum Contract Value. The minimum contract value is defined as the guaranteed monetary value of the aggregate orders issued during the base period only. The minimum will not guarantee orders for any particular item or group of items. The Government will not guarantee a minimum for the option periods.

The Government will compute a different minimum for each contract awarded under this solicitation, in accordance with the following formula:

10% of the aggregate of the extended dollar value of the minimum order quantity (MOQ) for the NSNs, computed as follows:

$10\% \times [\text{NSN1 price} \times \text{MOQ}] + [\text{NSN2 price} \times \text{MOQ}] + [\text{NSN3 price} \times \text{MOQ}] + \text{etc.}$

b. Maximum Contract Value. The maximum contract value is defined as 200% of the aggregate of the extended dollar value of the estimated value of the base period or each option period.

2. Contractors are directed to the solicitation's Pricing Workbook to obtain minimum delivery order quantities referred to in clause 52.216-19, Order Limitations (I67).

3. Evaluation criteria are indicated in both the solicitation and in addenda Section M. Given the evaluation criteria set forth in addenda Section M, clause 52.215-9G06, Evaluation and Award (M10G), should be deleted.

Further, the phrase "individual elements of the technical proposal under" is deleted and substituted with "similar" in the first sentence of paragraph 2.3.1 SubFactor P1: Corporate Experience, located in addenda Section M Evaluation Procedures. The revised sentence now reads: "The rating for corporate experience will be based upon the offeror's experience, its subcontractor's experience, or its employee's experience with a different company, in performing similar commercial or government contracts within the past five years."

4. Please note that this solicitation is FOB Origin. Clauses related to FOB Destination are deleted.
