Articles to be furnished hereunder shall be manufactured, tested and inspected in accordance with drawing number (76301) 74A350700 REV. "N", and all details and specifications referenced therein.

I. Quality/Inspection Requirements

- A. MIL-I-45208 or Equivalent applies: Refer to contract section E.
- B. First Article Testing applies: Refer to contract section I
- C. Mandatory Inspection applies: Refer to contract section C.

II. Supplemental Requirements

- A. Additionally, para. 3.1-3.5, 5.1-5.2, 6.1-6.2 of MIL-Q- 9858 or Equivalent applies.
- B. The contractor shall include on the detailed process/operation sheets developed, all in-house manufacturing processes and the identity of all manufacturing sources performing processes/ operations outside of their facilities. The notice of conditional approval or approval shall not relieve the contractor from complying with all requirements of the specifications and all other terms and conditions of this contract. Definition - Data which the contractor must develop for his internal use in performance of the primary contracted effort and does not require any substantial change to conform to Government requirements with regard to depth of content, format, frequency of submittal, preparation, control, and quality of the data item.

Estimated Price - Costs to be included under Group III are the administrative and other expenses related to reproducing and delivering such data item to the Government.

d. Group IV. Definition - Data which is developed by the contractor as part of his normal operating procedures and his effort supplying these data to the Government is minimal.

Estimated Price - Group IV items should normally be shown on the DD Form 1423 at no cost.

Item 18. For each data item, enter an amount equal to that portion of the total price which is estimated to be attributable to the production or development for the Government of that item of data.
